3 Meeting with Barratts/ David Wilson Homes	
At the proposed meeting shown above, a number of additional questions to those asked in the letter were identified from the question and answer summary document.  Note: now confirmed as the 16 <sup>th</sup> January at the Village Hall	DH to confirm meeting date.
It was agreed that the meeting should be held in a way that would encourage the Barratts/DWH representive to attend further meetings and so the question and answer summary and list of additional charges made by OM would be provided at the end of the meeting with a request to discuss at the next meeting.	
The questions for the meeting were to be those from the letter:	

Does your maintenance contract with OM Peverill conclude when all the properties on the site now known as Central Fernwood is complete? When do you expect that to be?

Please give your agreement to OM Peverill supplying the Parish Council with a copy of the contract under which they are engaged. OM Peverill have already given their agreement to this.

There would appear to be some difficulty in your maintenance of the area known as "The Meadow". Fernwood Parish Council seek your agreement for the Parish Council to take over the maintenance of this area.

In addition, the following issues were to be raised:

Poor communications from OM:

Accounting errors with people being incorrectly charged;

Disputed accounts being disposed of after 6 years:

The reason for the £1 annual rent charge and £50 administrative charge if not paid.

## 4 Meetings with OM

One point highlighted from the meeting with OM was their agreement DH to contact Fanfare to repay £9,000 regarding the incorrect gardening expense calculation for 2013. The Group thanked ST for her work with the accounts and persistence in pursuing OM, The refund was compared to the £5,000 that is given to Fernwood annually by Barratts/DWH. It was agreed that this success should be publicised in the Fanafare.

It was agreed that a further meeting with OM should be sought DH to arrange meeting towards the end of January to discuss the outstanding non financial questions. The Financial questions would form the basis of a future meeting in February at a date suitable to include ST.

## 5 Any Other Business

Mowing machine. It had previously been reported by OM that DH to contact OM Fernwood did not possess a mowing machine and none was listed on the inventory. DF reported that one had been purchased by Fernwood in 2009. It was agreed that this be pursued with OM.

Adoption. JW reported that the N&SDC adoption of parts of Fernwood JW to clarify what had would be effective from 1 January 2015. Exactly which parts need to been adopted. be clarified and JW said that he would be meeting with representatives from the Council soon to discuss road lining and other related issues. The Group wondered whether this would reduce the work of OM and if the maintenance contract costs would be reduced accordingly.
